

WHY PAY FOR SOMETHING THAT IS FREE?

In theory, theory and practice match. In practice, they do not.

Ronald Shakespear

By definition, digital material of academic level with Open Access is the one for which access is not required any registry, subscription or payment. This is the reason why at first sight it might seem counterintuitive to offer commercially a service that includes these documents.

It exists, no doubt, a justification for the extra value that could be added to this material by a company like ours (with decades of experience in assisting academic libraries around the world), in terms of selection, organization and cataloging.

Less obvious would be the status of Open Access in Latin America. While there are digital libraries, repositories and portals that work correctly, that is not the reality of most of the available material, which is dispersed, has a very variable quality, is hard to find and often ephemeral.

Below I detail some examples of publishers that have Open Access Ebook and would be a part of the OA-IM project. These cases were chosen not only to show a variety of publishers, but also to illustrate the different situations that can turn (and indeed do) the Open Access materials into a paradoxically inaccessible ones.

EXAMPLES OF PUBLISHERS

This is an example of University Press. Some universities have decided to make their material available on the web, free-of-charge. The problem lies in the diversity of ways of access to it.

Universidad Nacional de la Plata Facultad de Humanidades y Ciencias de la Educación. In 2013 we signed an agreement with the publisher of the faculty. All their books are available by Open Access and they choose Creative Commons.

They have 50 OA books. It is very difficult to access these books from the webpage, even knowing it it took us two hours to find them. This publisher has two access points, one for serials and another one for E-books. They mix papers with imprint and electronic monographs.

Governmental agencies. Some offer free access to their material, but its perpetuity on the web pages depends on the current administration instead of a long-term government policy.

Since the enactment of National Theater Act N° 24.800, *Instituto Nacional del Teatro* was created as governing body for the promotion and support of the theatrical activity throughout the country. The broad powers granted by the Law to the Institute allow the development, implementation and monitoring of a theatrical policy all around the country, and its federal character mainly benefits the provinces.

Instituto Nacional del Teatro gives special attention to plays of local authors and to the groups that perform them, favoring its highest artistic quality and enabling community access to this manifestation of culture.

Also, theatrical activities are promoted through contests, competitions, exhibitions and festivals; prizes and scholarships are awarded, local and regional particularities are respected and conservation and creation of theatrical spaces are stimulated, while knowledge of theater, its teaching, its practice and its history is spread.

This ONG was created in 1988 with the goal of promoting Argentine theater. It has 112 academic publications, essays, plays and papers.

They were published imprint and are also found free-of-charge at its website. The interesting thing about this material is that there are 42 titles that are not available in any library through: https://www.worldcat.org. All PDFs re unedited, with the raw file sent to the printer.

Colectivo El Topo Blindado was formed around a core of researchers in the field of the exploration of recent history in our country. Since their common interest in the origin and development of the political-military organizations, they undertook a journey that focused in the study and research, conducting workshops and discussions of this subject, and in the production of articles and investigations that they are now making public. Those who support this initiative try to contribute to the spreading and deepening of a History that is far beyond having been covered in its complex dimension, in the framework of a debate with those historiographical and theoretical



groups that with marked emphasis tried to demonize a political and organizational experience of huge influence in the national political life. Far from circumscribing the history of the Argentine guerrilla to topics as "spirit" and "sacrificial mandate", "death drive", "full life" and quite simply "craziness", the intention of the publisher is to encourage debate, recovering names, organizational experiences and ideas that were part of the armed policies of the Sixties and Seventies, largely manifested in organizations that, in the best case, barely fill an anecdotal place in a sea of acronyms not yet untangled in the political rationality and practical experience.

There are hundreds of such organizations formed by a group of intellectuals in order to spread their ideas. Gabriel Rot is the coordinator of this publishing house that is often financed by his own money. This makes free access of this material to be conditioned in time.
